SS Class classifications are determined according to the Copper Service that is provided by Telstra to a Premises and the Access Technology that NBN Co has used or proposes to use to make a Premises NBN Serviceable (that is, "*" - P" = FTTP Access Technology, "*" - N" = FTTN, "*" - B" = FTTB and "*" - H" = via HFC). For example, "Ethernet Lite – P" is the Copper Service (that is a Direct Special Service) known as "Ethernet Lite" which is provided to Premises that NBN Co has used or proposes to use to make NBN Serviceable using the FTTP Access Technology.

* SS Disconnection Dates and Cease Sale Dates also apply to ULLS that have been certified by Wholesale customers as Special Service Inputs (SSI) used to supply services which are Service Equivalent to Direct Special Services within the relevant Access Service Family.
